Saturday:

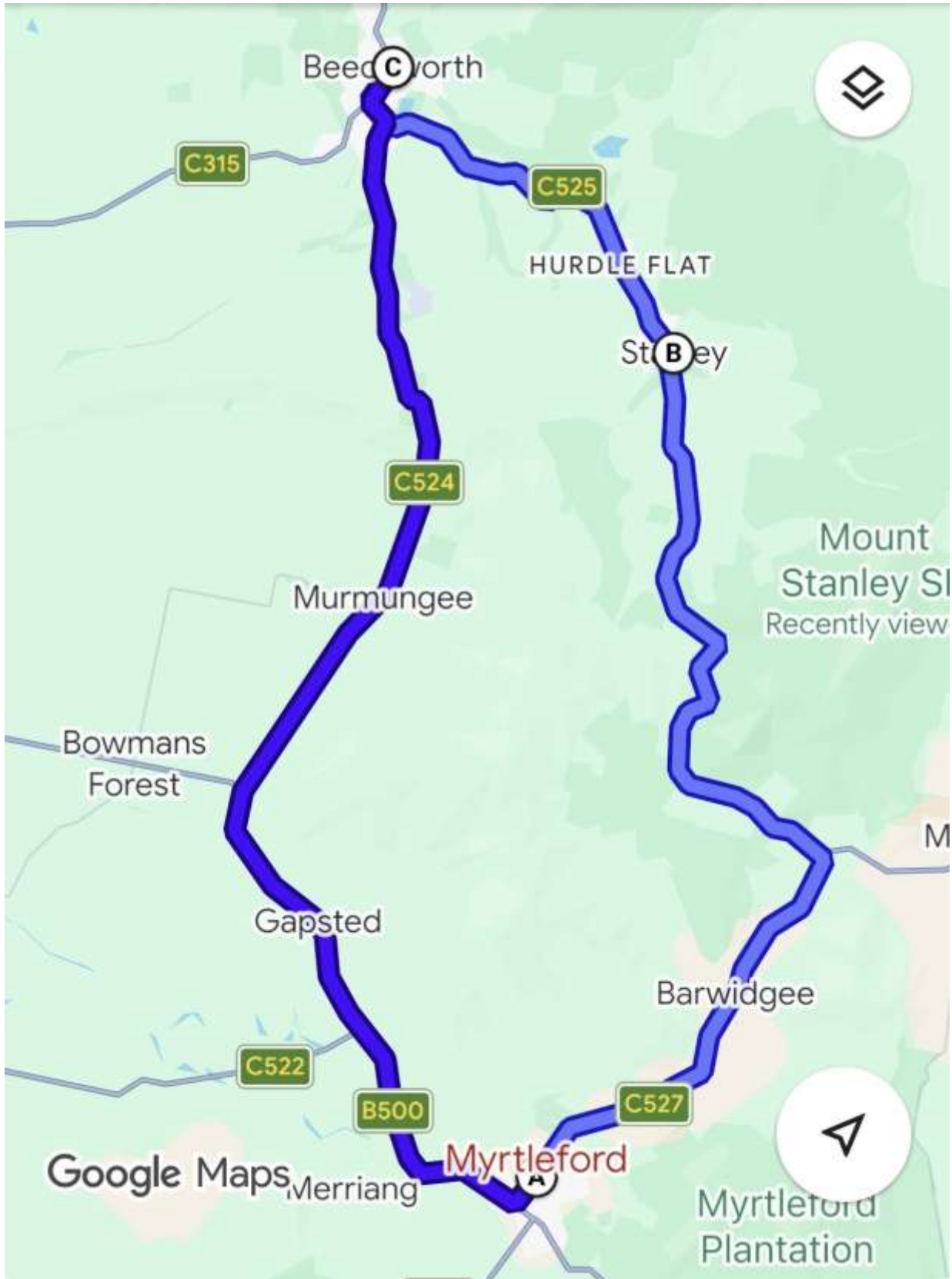
61Km Loop Ride.
